

**ORDINANCE NO. 190-09-139**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL CODE OF ORDINANCES, APPENDIX G, FRANCHISES, ARTICLE III, GARBAGE, REFUSE AND TRASH, EXHIBIT "A" AMENDING THE RATE SCHEDULE OF FEES EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2019; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, CHARLES FARANDA)**

SECTION 1. That the City of Lauderhill Code of Ordinances Appendix G, Franchises, Article III, Garbage, Refuse and Trash, Rate Schedule is hereby amended to be retroactively effective to October 1, 2019 to read as follows:

ARTICLE III. - GARBAGE, REFUSE AND TRASH<sup>41</sup>

The Franchise Agreement with Waste Management, Inc. of Florida to provide solid waste collection services is hereby approved commencing October 1, ~~2016~~—2019 and ending September 30, ~~2019~~ 2024 pursuant to the exercise of a five-year option to extend.

**EXHIBIT "A"**

**RATE SCHEDULE—INCLUSIVE OF FRANCHISE FEE**

For services required to be performed under this Contract, the charges shall be as follows:

**FRANCHISE FEE**

The CONTRACTOR shall pay to the CITY of Lauderhill as and for a franchise fee, the amount equal to twenty percent (20%) or the dollar amount reflected in the Franchise Fee table below, whichever is greater, if the City elects to provide billing. If the CONTRACTOR does the billing for services rendered, pursuant to this Agreement, within the CITY of Lauderhill the rate of eighteen percent (18%) or the dollar amount reflected in the Franchise Fee table below, whichever is greater.

**DELINQUENT ACCOUNT CHARGES FOR RESIDENTIAL SERVICES**

Late Fees:

Percentage charged on past due balances (over 30 days) not to exceed maximum rate allowed by State law. ~~Currently, the monthly rate charge is 1.00%, unless otherwise provided above.~~ 1.5% or the current maximum permitted by law.

Non-sufficient Fund Checks:

Charge for customer check which does not clear their bank account ~~\$20.00~~ or 5% ~~(whichever is greater)~~ shall be in accordance with Florida Statutes, 68.065 and City Code Section 14-8.

Any additional payment penalties will be subject to the City Manager's approval.
