

RESOLUTION NO. 26R-01-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS TO AUTHORIZE A PIGGYBACK OF THE BROWARD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE RLI# 24023VR WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT PSYCHOLOGICAL AND COUNSELING ASSOCIATES INC., FOR PRE-EMPLOYMENT PSYCHOLOGICAL EVALUATION SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PIGGYBACK AGREEMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-144 of the City's Code, the City of Lauderhill ("City") may waive its requirements on competitive bidding and join in on cooperative purchasing plans when in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Broward County Sheriff's Office issued solicitation RLI# 24023VR for Pre-Employment Psychological Evaluation Services and entered an agreement with Law Enforcement Psychological and Counseling Associates Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City, pursuant to section 2-144 of the City's Code, wishes to piggyback from Broward Sheriff's Office RLI# 24023VR and enter into an agreement with Law Enforcement Psychological and Counseling Associates Inc., to provide services for pre-employment psychological evaluations as needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The above recitations are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City is authorized to piggyback Broward Sheriff's Office RLI # 24023VR with Law Enforcement Psychological and Counseling Associates Inc., to receive services, as needed, for pre-employment psychological evaluations.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a piggyback agreement with Law Enforcement Psychological and Counseling Associates Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00.

SECTION 4. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
