

RESOLUTION NO. 26R-05-80

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A SOLE SOURCE PROPOSAL FROM TOMCO2 SYSTEMS FOR REPAIRS OF THE EXISTING CO2 UNIT AT THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$77,929.68; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TOMCO2 SYSTEMS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$77,929.68 TO BE PAID FROM THE APPROPRIATE BUDGET CODE; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, the City's existing CO2 unit at the water treatment plant is a critical component of the water treatment process and the system is currently in need of repairs to restore optimal performance and ensure continued compliance with regulatory requirements; and

WHEREAS, Tomco2 Systems has been identified as a sole source provider due to its specialized expertise, proprietary knowledge of the equipment, and role as the original manufacturer/vendor. Tomco2 Systems' familiarity with the system ensures compatibility of parts, minimizes downtime, and reduces risks associated with third-party modifications; and

WHEREAS, the City Staff recommends the City Commission accepts the proposal from Tomco2 Systems in an amount not to exceed \$77,929.68.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby accepts the proposal from Tomco2 Systems in an amount not to exceed \$77,929.68, said payment to be made from the appropriate budget code.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Tomco2 Systems to repair the CO2 unit at the water treatment plant.

SECTION 4. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
