

RESOLUTION NO. 19R-06-121

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF SPECIALIZED FIELD TEST KITS CAPABLE OF DETECTING 1% OR MORE THC CONTENT FROM THE SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER SYNDICATE ALLIANCE; WAIVING BIDDING REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000.00 FROM THE STATE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (LETF) IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE GUIDELINES FROM BUDGET CODE NUMBER 120-683-9935; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, CHARLES FARANDA)

WHEREAS, SB 1020 is before the Governor for signature and is anticipated to become a law which will go into effect on July 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, this law creates a state hemp program to regulate the hemp industry, redefines cannabis, and removes hemp from the controlled substances list; and

WHEREAS, a new Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) field test kit is necessary in order to detect the lower level of THC present in hemp; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-141 of the City of Lauderhill Code of Ordinances, designated situations where competitive bidding is not required; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-141(c) provides that non-competitive supplies such as products that are available only from a sole source, such as unique, custom, patented or franchise supplies or services are exempt from the competitive bidding requirements; and

WHEREAS, Syndicate Alliance has represented that they are the sole source provider of the 1% content THC field test kits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived, as this purchase is exempt from the competitive bidding requirements pursuant to Section 2-141(c) of the City Code since Syndicate Alliance is hereby designated as a sole source provider of 1% content THC field test kits.

SECTION 2. That the purchase of 1% Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) field test kits from the sole source provider Syndicate Alliance is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. That payment in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00, on an as needed basis, is hereby authorized from the State Local Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF), which in accordance with State Guidelines, from Budget Code Number 120-683-

9935.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
