



ARC South Florida Region

- The South Florida Region has already been delivering preparedness messages in a COVID-19 environment to the citizens of Broward & Miami- Dade counties leading up to Hurricane Season.
- We have actively engaged with Broward & Miami-Dade counties in the past to assist in training shelter workers as needed. This partnership began prior to hurricane season four years ago. Virtual training opportunities for our partners is available.
- We offered to provide the same assistance as last year. Committed to supporting evacuation shelters pre-landfall. If needed within 72 hours post landfall, we will work with Emergency Management to transition all families and individuals into longer term shelters operated by the American Red Cross. Shelters will follow CDC guidelines to protect the safety of our workforce and clients.

ARC South Florida Region

- Staff & Volunteers participated in our Regional Disaster Exercise drill in preparation for this hurricane season. Additionally, we continue to offer enhanced virtual training workshops in preparation of hurricane season with sheltering in a COVID-19 environment a key priority.
- There has been no service delivery interruptions since COVID-19. We've been responding to floods, home fires, wildfires, FBI Shooting, etc.
- Our teams are ready to respond and meet the needs of the community should we be called upon.
