

RESOLUTION NO. 20R-06-92

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL FLORIDA APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION THROUGH THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO) FOR A PLANNING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (PTAP) GRANT FOR TRANSIT IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR N.W. 55TH AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR AT LEAST A 10% MATCH IN LOCAL FUNDS OR \$10,000.00, WHICHEVER IS GREATER, IN AN AMOUNT TO BE DETERMINED IN THE EVENT OF APPROVAL OF THE APPLICATION; PROVIDING FOR ACCEPTANCE OF THE AWARD AND EXECUTION OF NECESSARY DOCUMENTS PENDING LEGAL REVIEW; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY INTERIM CITY MANAGER, DESORAE GILES-SMITH)

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill wishes to identify a transit improvement plan for N.W. 55th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Planning Technical Assistance Program (PTAP) Grants are administered to local governments throughout the State of Florida via an application through the Broward County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHEREAS, PTAP Grant funds are now available for selected transit improvement plan projects; and

WHEREAS, the transit improvement plan for N.W. 55th Avenue will be conducted within the City limits of the City of Lauderhill and within Broward County; and

WHEREAS, the Broward MPO requires, and the City agrees to provide, a Resolution of support for the transit improvement plan for N.W. 55th Avenue project to be completed within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Broward MPO requires, and the City agrees to provide, a Resolution endorsing the City of Lauderhill's transit improvement plan for N.W. 55th Avenue funding eligibility from the Broward MPO PTAP Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, the Broward MPO requires, and the City agrees to provide, a commitment to fund construction costs exceeding the \$10,000.00 maximum award amount under the PTAP Grant program in the event of grant approval, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Division, Engineering Department, and Financial Department recommend submission of the PTAP Grant application and acceptance of the award in the event of approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Lauderhill to apply for a PTAP Grant for the transit improvement plan for N.W. 55th Avenue project via an application through the Broward MPO and to accept the award and execute the necessary documents, subject to legal review and approval.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1: The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are HEREBY ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are HEREBY made a specific part of this Resolution. All exhibits attached hereto and referenced herein are expressly incorporated and made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2: The City Manager, her designees and all other appropriate City Officials are hereby authorized to apply for a Planning Technical Assistance Program (PTAP) Grant via an application through the Broward County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for project costs in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 for a transit improvement plan for N.W. 55th Avenue. A copy of the supporting documents are attached hereto as a Composite Exhibit and are incorporated herein by reference thereto.

Section 3: Upon approval of the PTAP Grant application, the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill hereby accepts the award and authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute the necessary documents following legal review and approval.

Section 4: All Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5: If any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this Resolution.

Section 6: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
