AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE IV, CITY COMMISSION, SECTION 2-163, DEBATE AND DECORUM; SETTING TIME LIMIT FOR SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY VICE MAYOR SARAI "RAY" MARTIN)

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City of Lauderhill Code of Ordinances Chapter 2, Administration, Article IV, City Commission, Section 2-163, Debate and Decorum, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-163. Debate and decorum.

* * *

(b) Time limits on discussion. Reports of the city manager or city attorney as provided for on the agenda will be limited to fifteen (15) minutes unless authorized to be increased by a consensus of the commission; otherwise, all other discussion is without any time limit. Notwithstanding same, the presiding officer can limit discussion in order to thwart any filibuster attempt. Notwithstanding the foregoing, general presentations by the public shall not exceed five (5) minutes. Special presentations that are requested by, on behalf of, or paid for by, the city shall not be subject to the five a ten (10) minute time limitation. Time limits provided for herein may be increased upon consensus of the commission.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances, all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed as to the extent of such conflict.
