

RESOLUTION NO. 21R-04-75

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL DECLARING THAT CERTAIN CITY-OWNED PROPERTY ALONG STATE ROAD 7/U.S. 441, AS DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED LEGAL DESCRIPTION AND SKETCH, TO BE SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER IN THE MOST COST EFFECTIVE AND FAVORABLE MANNER PURSUANT TO CITY CODE SECTION 2-143; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, DESORAE GILES-SMITH)

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill Code of Ordinances, Section 2-143(b) provides methods for the disposal of surplus stock; and

WHEREAS, the city wishes to dispose of a certain city-owned property along State Road 7/U.S. 441, as described in the attached legal description and sketch, which it has deemed to be surplus in the most cost effective and favorable manner subject to city commission approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission hereby declares the city-owned parcel of land located along State Road 7/U.S. 441 as more particularly described in the legal description and sketch, a copy of this is attached hereto as Composite Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein, to be surplus and authorizes the transfer of same in the most cost effective and favorable manner pursuant to City Code Section 2-143.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
