

RESOLUTION 21R-08-179

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL AMENDING RESOLUTION 21R-07-137 TO AWARD CONTRACTS FOR DISASTER DEBRIS REMOVAL TO ALL OF THE TOP THREE RANKED FIRMS PURSUANT TO RFP #2021-012 AS RECOMMENDED BY THE EVALUATION COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT FROM THE APPROPRIATE BUDGET CODE NUMBER(S); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE CONTRACTS WITH ALL THREE OF THE RANKED FIRMS FOR SERVICES ON AN AS NEEDED BASIS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, DESORAE GILES-SMITH).

WHEREAS, Resolution 21R-07-137 ranked the top three firms to provide Disaster Debris Removal, but only allowed for the contract negotiation with the top ranked firm; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the city staff was to authorize the City Manager to negotiate contracts with all three of the ranked firms so that backup vendors are available for actual debris removal during a state of emergency on an as needed basis, since often times companies are required to mobilize and tend to various other sites of emergency and are not always available to readily provide the services necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The following firms, that were already previously ranked via Resolution 21R-07-137 for Disaster Debris Removal pursuant to RFP #2021-012, as recommended by the Evaluation Committee, are permitted to have contracts entered into with them to all be available on an as needed basis for debris removal:

1. CERES ENVIRONMENTAL
2. DRC EMERGENCY SERVICE
3. KDF ENTERPRISES

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager, or any designee thereof, to negotiate an agreement with all three (3) of the ranked selected firms to provide Disaster Debris Removal, pursuant to RFP #2021-012 on an as needed basis.

SECTION 3. Approving appropriation and payment as necessary from the appropriate Budget Code Number(s).

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
