

RESOLUTION NO. 21R-03-53

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 20R-02-37 WHICH SUPPORTED THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO) AND THE CITY OF LAUDERDALE LAKES IN ITS EFFORT TO COORDINATE THE TRANSPORTATION PLANNING FOR THE N.W. 31ST AVENUE TRANSPORTATION/TRANSIT RELATED CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT NOW FROM BROWARD BOULEVARD TO W. MCNAB ROAD; APPROVING THE SUBSEQUENTLY REVISED SCOPE OF WORK; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, DESORAE GILES-SMITH).

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill previously expressed its support and approved the Broward MPO and City of Lauderdale Lakes, acting as lead city, in their efforts to coordinate the Transportation planning for the N.W. 31ST Avenue transportation/transit related corridor improvement project via Resolution No. 20R-02-37; and

WHEREAS, since the passage of Resolution 20R-02-37, the Scope of Work was revised, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That Resolution No. 20R-02-37 is hereby amended and approved to substitute the Revised Scope of Work, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein to now include the project limits extended to include N.W. 31ST Avenue from W. Broward Blvd. to McNab Road.

Section 2. That the City of Lauderhill continues to support partnering with Broward County local government jurisdictions for the N.W. 31ST Avenue Transportation/ Transit related Corridor Improvement Project, as described in the revised Scope of Services.

Section 3. That the City of Lauderhill hereby continues to support the Broward MPO in its effort to coordinate the application for the N.W. 31ST Avenue Transportation/Transit related Corridor Improvement Project, as described in the revised Scope of Services.

Section 4. That the City of Lauderhill continues to express its support and joins with the City of Lauderdale Lakes as the lead applicant for the N.W. 31ST Avenue Transportation/Transit related Corridor Improvement Project.

Section 5. That it hereby directs the City Clerk to transmit an executed copy of this Resolution to the Broward County Government, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization, and the City of Lauderdale Lakes.

Section 6. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
