A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SAFEWARE, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO DRONES BASED ON A PIGGYBACK FROM THE COUNTY OF FAIRFAX, VIRGINIA'S REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS AND AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FROM THE APPROPRIATE BUDGET CODE NUMBER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY INTERIM CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-144 of the City's Code, the City of Lauderhill ("City") may waive its on competitive bidding and join in on cooperative purchasing plans when in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the County of Fairfax, Virginia, issued an RFP for Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness Equipment and Related Service and awarded a contract to Safeware, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City, pursuant to section 2-144 of the City's Code, wishes to piggyback from the County of Fairfax, Virginia solicitation and enter into an agreement with Safeware, Inc., for the purchase of two drones at a cost not to exceed \$50,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The above recitations are true and correct.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That the City is authorized to enter into an agreement with Safeware for the purchase of two drones at a cost not to exceed \$50,000.

SECTION 3. Payment shall be made from the appropriate budget code number.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
