THIS AWARD WILL REPRESENT A TWO (2) YEAR CONTRACT FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2016- AUGUST 21, 2018 WITH TWO (2) ADDITIONAL TWO (2) YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS. THE CONTRACT INCLUDES ROADSIDE ASSISTANCE. ALL ELEMENTS OF THE CONTRACT HAVE BEEN REVIEWED AND HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED BY PURCHASING AND BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT. INSURANCE WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL.
