

ORDINANCE NO. 190-09-135

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 21, WATER AND SEWER SERVICE, ARTICLE IV, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND ENGINEERING SERVICES RULES, REGULATIONS, AND RATES; AMENDING SECTION 21-47, SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES, TABLE 4, WATER SYSTEM MINIMUM CHARGE/AVAILABILITY CHARGE; AND TABLE 5, WATER SYSTEM VOLUMETRIC RATE; AND TABLE 6, SEWER RATES AVAILABILITY CHARGE AND VOLUMETRIC RATE TABLE TO AMEND THE RATE STRUCTURES FOR WATER AND SEWER; PROVIDING THAT THE NEW RATE STRUCTURE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2019; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, CHARLES FARANDA)

WHEREAS, that the City Commission has determined that the following rates are just and equitable and are reasonable and necessary in relation to the services being provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City of Lauderhill Code of Ordinances Chapter 21, Water and Sewer Service, Article IV. Department of Environmental and Engineering Services Rules, Regulations and Rates, Section 21-47, Schedule of Rates and Charges, is hereby amended to be effective October 1, 2019, to read as follows:

- (e) *Water volumetric rates.* Commencing December 1, 2007, and effective on the 1st of October of each year thereafter, all water rates will be adjusted automatically in accordance with one hundred (100) percent of the U.S. Department of Labor Consumer Price Index as determined in June of the calendar year of adjustment, unless indicated otherwise.

- (f) *Sewer rates—Availability fees and volumetric rate.* A fixed charge per service (sewer) for each ebu connected to the system without regard to the amount of sewer usage, including zero (0) amount shall be as follows. Commencing December 1, 2007 and effective on the 1st of October of each year thereafter, all sewer minimum charges/availability rates and volumetric rates will be adjusted automatically in accordance with one hundred (100) percent of the U.S. Department of Labor Consumer Price Index as determined in June of the calendar year of adjustment, unless indicated otherwise.
