Request Action:

Approval of Ordinance amending Chapter 6, Article IV, Building Safety Inspection Program, to align with updated state law.

Need Summary Explanation/ Background:

To ensure the City's Building Safety Inspection Program is consistent with the 2025 amendments to F.S. § 553.899 and to provide clear procedures, deadlines, and reporting requirements for Phase One and Phase Two milestone inspections. The 2025 Legislature amended F.S. § 553.899 to strengthen milestone inspection requirements. This ordinance updates Chapter 6, Article IV to retitle the program, align with state law, and update reporting provisions to ensure compliance and protect public safety.
