

RESOLUTION NO. 17R-02-58

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REMETERING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL AND RICHARD MORGAN TO ALLOW SUBMETERS AT THE TRIPLEX PROPERTY LOCATED AT 2311-2315 N.W. 59TH WAY, LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA IN ORDER TO SEPARATELY BILL EACH INDIVIDUAL USER BASED UPON ACTUAL WATER CONSUMPTION AT THE SAME RATE UTILIZED BY THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, CHARLES FARANDA)

WHEREAS, Section 21-46 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lauderhill requires all property owners currently having individual water meters to enter into an express written agreement with the City for the provision of those services which allows the owner to separately bill each Individual User based upon actual water consumption and in a manner consistent with the rates utilized by the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Remetering Agreement between the City of Lauderhill and Richard Morgan to allow the triplex property located at 2311-2315 N.W. 59th Way, Lauderhill, Florida in order to separately bill each Individual User based upon actual water consumption, at the same rate utilized by the City, and subject to all the limitations contained therein, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. The City Manager and all appropriate city officials are authorized to execute this Agreement and any other documents required to fulfill the terms of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
