Need:

TO APPOINT THE MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL'S AUDITOR SELECTION COMMITTEE.

Summary Explanation/ Background:

FLORIDA STATUES, SECTION 218.391 REQUIRES THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY TO ESTABLISH AN AUDITOR SELECTION COMMITTEE TO ASSIST THE CITY COMMISSION IN SELECTING AN AUDITOR BY PREPARING A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS, EVALUATING THE RESPONSES, AND THEN RANKING AND RECOMMENDING AN AUDITOR. THE COMMISSION HAS EXPRESSED IT'S DESIRE THAT THE COMMITTEE BE COMPRISED OF FIVE (5) MEMBERS, WITH THREE (3) OF THE MEMBERS BEING EXTERNAL TO THE CITY AND TWO (2) OF THE MEMBERS BEING INTERNAL.
