STAFF RECOMMENDS APPROVAL OF THE SALTZ MICHELSON ARCHITECTS, INC. PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE DESIGN CRITERIA DRAWINGS FOR A DESIGN BUILD PROJECT TO PROVIDE IMPROVEMENTS TO WOLK PARK. THE PROPOSED PROJECT ELEMENTS INCLUDE A NEW BUILDING, REHABILITATION OF THE TENNIS COURTS AND POOL, NEW FENCING, A NEW PAVILION, AND INCORPORATION OF A CHILDREN'S SPLASH AREA.
