RESOLUTION NO. 17R-03-77: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, URGING THE BROWARD COUNTY COMMISSION TO ADOPT A COUNTYWIDE ORDINANCE WHICH HOLDS VENUES, BUSINESSES, AND OTHER RESPONSIBLE PARTIES ACCOUNTABLE FOR SNIPE SIGNS AND POSTERS UNLAWFULLY PLACED ON UTILITY POLES, UTILITY BOXES, TRAFFIC CONTROL BOXES, BUS SHELTERS, BENCHES, TREES, OR ANY OTHER PUBLIC PROPERTY; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO BROWARD COUNTY AND THE BROWARD LEAGUE OF CITIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY COMMISSIONER HAYWARD J. BENSON, JR.)

Request Action:

Pass a resolution to support a countywide ordinance to hold the venues, businesses, or other responsible parties accountable for snipe signs and posted unlawfully placed on public property.

Need:

To try to reduce the number of snipe signs and posters that are placed on public property.

Summary Explanation/ Background:

Snipe signs and posters are frequently placed throughout the city. This creates an eyesore and an unnecessary expense to the city to have to use staff time to remove the signs in order to beautify the city. Sometimes the placement of these signs can even create a safety hazard in streets. Commissioner Hayward J. Benson, Jr. has requested a resolution to support the Broward County Commission passing a countywide ordinance which would hole the venues, businesses or other responsible party named in the content of the snipe sign or post responsible for the illegal placement of any of theirs signs.
