A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT (VOCA) GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AND THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL; PROVIDING FOR THE CITY TO RECEIVE GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF UP TO \$166,488.00 AND PROVIDING THAT THE MATCH REQUIREMENT HAS BEEN WAIVED; PROVIDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, DESORAE GILES-SMITH)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant Agreement between the State of Florida Office of the Attorney General and the City of Lauderhill, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Providing that the City of Lauderhill will receive grant funding in an amount up to \$166,488.00 for reimbursements related to costs for victim services programs under the VOCA Grant.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. Providing that there is no matching requirement as it has been waived.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> The City Manager, Police Chief, and all appropriate city officials are authorized to execute the contracts and any other documents required to fulfill the terms of this resolution. Any documents that were already executed in connection with this grant are approved retroactively. The City's chief administrative officer, or designee, is hereby directed and authorized to act in connection with the grant application and to provide such additional information as may be required.
