

**RESOLUTION 26R-05-83**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, UPDATING AND REVISING THE CITY'S VEHICLE USE POLICY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).**

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill has an established Vehicle Use Policy to ensure that City vehicles are used for official government use only and the Policy provides public officers and employees with the City's protocol for the appropriate use, operation, and maintenance of all city non-public safety vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle Use Policy has been updated and revised for consideration by the City Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The updated and revised Vehicle Use Policy is hereby adopted, a copy of which is attached hereto.

Section 2. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
