The US Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, has announced that the Lauderhill Police Department is eligible to receive a total award amount of \$48,905 in the ***Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program FY 2022 Local Solicitation***. These funds are to be used to assist the department's efforts to prevent and reduce narcotic and drug activity and related violent crimes and shooting incidents throughout the city, by launching Operation Clean Up. Crime Scene technology will be purchased to increase the overall effectiveness and efficiency of the Criminal Investigations Division as it relates to capturing evidence, taking criminals off the streets and reducing community violence.
