

RESOLUTION NO. 24R-02-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPROVING THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AMNESTY LIEN REDUCTION PROGRAM TO PROVIDE RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL PROPERTY OWNERS WITH AN ALTERNATIVE FOR SIGNIFICANT LIEN REDUCTION ONCE ALL VIOLATIONS ARE BROUGHT INTO COMPLIANCE TO FURTHER EXTEND THE DURATION THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024; PROVIDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, DESORAE GILES-SMITH)

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 23R-02-59 approved the establishment of an Amnesty Lien Reduction Program to provide residential and commercial property owners with an alternative for significant lien reduction once all violations are brought into compliance which was originally effective through September 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 23R-09-238 approved a modification to the program to extend the duration through December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution would approve a second amendment to the program to allow for a further extension through June 30, 2024;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the second amendment to the Amnesty Lien Reduction Program to extend it through June 30, 2024, with all other provisions remaining in effect, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. The City Manager, or other appropriate city officials, are authorized to execute all necessary documents to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
