A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, AWARING REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) NO. 2026-018 – LABORATORY AND REAGENT SERVICES FOR CITY WATER FACILITIES TO ADVANCED ENVIRONMENTAL LABORATORIES, INC.; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SELECTED FIRM TO FURNISH ALL NECESSARY LABOR, SUPPLIES, MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT, AND INCIDENTAL ITEMS TO SATISFACTORILY PERFORM THE LABORATORY SERVICES AND SAMPLING PROCEDURES DETAILED IN THE TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS ON AN AS NEEDED BASIS; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, the City issued RFP No. 2026-018 – Laboratory and Reagent Services for City Water Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City received a single response, submitted by Advanced Environmental Laboratories, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City staff recommends the City Commission award RFP No. 2026-018 – Laboratory and Reagent Services for City Water Facilities to Advanced Environmental Laboratories, Inc., in the amount of \$31,207.78.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby awards RFP No. 2026-018 – Laboratory and Reagent Services for City Water Facilities to Advanced Environmental Laboratories, Inc., in the amount of \$31,207.78

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement with Advanced Environmental Laboratories, Inc., to furnish all necessary labor, supplies, materials, equipment, and incidental items to satisfactorily perform the laboratory services and sampling procedures detailed in the technical specifications on an as needed basis.

SECTION 4. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
