RESOLUTION NO. 24R-10-256: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE LOCAL AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE BY THE COMMISSION AS A WHOLE FOR THE REMAINDER OF A FOUR (4) YEAR TERM EXPIRING JUNE 2028 TO FILL VACANT POSITIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Request Action:

Adopt a Resolution appointing members to serve on the Local Affordable Housing Advisory Committee by the Commission as a Whole, for the remainder of a four (4) year term, expiring June 2028.

Need Summary Explanation/ Background:

The committee must consist of one representative from at least six (6) of the eleven (11) categories listed, as outlined in Florida Statute 420.9076. If at least six (6) of eleven (11) categories are currently filled, two members may hold a position in the same category.

There are currently six (6) vacant seats on the committee and the City Clerk's Office has the following applications on file from individuals meeting the listed criteria:

Cynthia Horat, a citizen who is actively engaged as an advocate for low-income persons in connection with affordable housing.

Sharon Parry, a citizen who is actively engaged as an advocate for low-income persons in connection with affordable housing.

Tania Stuart, a citizen who is actively engaged as a not-for-profit provider of affordable housing.

Kristian Willingham, a citizen who resides within the jurisdiction of the local governing body making the appointments.
