

**RESOLUTION NO. 26R-05- 87**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, AWARDED THE KEY TO THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL TO BISHOP DR. JACQUELINE E. MCCULLOUGH IN RECOGNITION OF HER EXTRAORDINARY MINISTRY, HUMANITARIAN SERVICE, SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP, AND GLOBAL IMPACT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY MAYOR DENISE D. GRANT).**

WHEREAS, Bishop Dr. Jacqueline McCullough is a distinguished international preacher, humanitarian, educator, author, songwriter and spiritual leader whose life and ministry have impacted countless individuals throughout the United States and around the world; and

WHEREAS, Bishop McCullough is the Senior Pastor and Founder of the International Gathering at Beth Rapha in Pomona, New York, as well as the General Overseer of The Rapha Alliance, a fellowship of 18 churches; and

WHEREAS, Bishop McCullough's leadership extends beyond the walls of the church, as she actively engages with the community to address their needs, promote unity, and inspire hope in the hearts of many; and

WHEREAS, Bishop McCullough is an accomplished author of several inspirational and faith-centered works, including Daily Moments with God; In Quietness and Confidence, 105 Days of Prayer, Satisfaction of the Soul, The Other Side of This, I Hate My Life, and The Lockett, in addition to releasing praise and worship recordings entitled This is for You Lord and a New Sound; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission believes that Bishop Dr. Jacqueline McCullough's unwavering commitment to serving others and her dedication to uplifting communities make her an ideal candidate for the Key to the City of Lauderhill.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:**

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill hereby awards a Key to the City of Lauderhill to Bishop Dr. Jacqueline E.
