The Coalition serves as an information, education, and networking resource for organizations as well as the community. The purpose of the BHTC is to impact the response to victims of human trafficking & sexual exploitation through informational outreach and advocacy activities, to coordinate informational, educational, and training seminars, and identify resources available. Due to its collaborative role in combating this heinous crime, the BHTC is viewed as a national model, a forerunner in bringing "systems" together to prevent, prosecute, protect, and partner.

Every January during National Human Trafficking Awareness Month, BHTC produces/host awareness events. The goal of these events is primarily to raise community awareness, educate and provide a safe space for agencies & the community to learn, network and collaborate in their efforts to combat human trafficking & exploitation.

BHTC Board of Directors, its speakers and members are unpaid volunteers who give freely of their time and expertise throughout the year in speaking engagements and training sessions within our Broward community.

The 3 scenes are performed separately and the facilitator freezes the scenes to engage in rich dialogue between the audience members and characters who stay in character even throughout audience interaction.
