

RESOLUTION NO. 26R-06-100

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR THE USE OF A TEMPORARY TENT STRUCTURE FROM FIVE (5) DAYS TO FORTY-FIVE (45) DAYS RELATING TO AN EVENT PERMIT APPLICATION FILED BY SYNAGOGUE OF INVERRARY LOCATED AT 6700 NW 44TH STREET, LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA; PROVIDING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY WITH THE AUTHORITY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, the Synagogue of Inverrary supports the services of the City by providing summer programs to youth in the City; and

WHEREAS, South Florida is experiencing a heat wave where temperatures reach daily between 105 and 110 degrees; and

WHEREAS, the Synagogue is seeking to install a temporary tent structure on its property to provide children attending the summer programs a safe place from the heat; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission believes it is in the best interest of the City to authorize the City Manager or designee to extend the time for the use of a temporary tent structure from five (5) days to forty-five (45) days relating to an event permit application filed by Synagogue of Inverrary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitations are true and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Lauderhill hereby authorizes the City Manager or designee to extend the time for the use of a temporary tent structure from five (5) days to forty-five (45) days starting from June 29, 2026 relating to an event permit application filed by the Synagogue of Inverrary located at 6700 NW 44th Street.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager and City Attorney to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
