A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, AWARDING THE KEY TO THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL TO DEPUTY POLICE CHIEF ALLEN SIEGEL FOR HIS SERVICE AND COMMITMENT TO THE PEOPLE OF LAUDERHILL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY MAYOR DENISE GRANT AND COMMISSIONER SARAI "RAY" MARTIN).

WHEREAS, Deputy Police Chief Allen Siegel started his career with the City of Lauderhill in February 2012, after serving 28 years with the Hollywood Police Department and;

WHEREAS, throughout his career in Lauderhill, Deputy Police Chief Siegel held the positions of Assistant Police Chief and then Deputy Police Chief where he was given a variety of operational and administrative assignments; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Police Chief Siegel has an extensive investigative background in the Criminal Investigations Division, as well as command assignments to the Office of National Drug Control Policy's High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Task Force. Deputy Police Chief Siegel also served for more than nine years as a supervisor and commander for the Special Weapons and Tactics team; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Police Chief Siegel has spent his life learning at all levels having earned a Bachelor's Degree in Professional Studies from Barry University and a Master's Degree in Public Administration from Nova Southeastern University. He is also a graduate of the 33rd Management College of the Southwestern Law Enforcement Institute at the University of Texas at Dallas. Moreover, Deputy Police Chief Siegel attended in 2006, the Police Executive Research Forum's Senior Management Institute for Police at Boston University; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill is proud to honor individuals who contribute positively to the community and the broader society through their dedication to learning, protecting the community and promoting the general wellbeing of citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:
