The RapidID Server software will then use CJNET to submit fingerprints to the FDLE RapidID system.

When used as an all-in-one device the fingerprint search responses are displayed on the Evolution RapidID device, therefore it does not need to be paired to a computer. The unit can be passed around to different officers very easily since it is not dedicated to a specific laptop. The operator logs into the device with user name, password and fingerprint. This method meets the FBI CJIS Security policy for mobile devices.

The RID edge device detailed in this proposal has been certified by FDLE to connect to and register with the Falcon Rapid ID system.
