The Safe Neighborhood Districts were created to provide a more secure community for our residents. The Habitat Safe Neighborhood District was created in 2011 by the City. Residents in Habitat voted, by referendum, to create the districts and levy taxes to collect funds to make their neighborhoods safer.

The assessment will be collected by the district in the approximate amount of \$72,219.
