

RESOLUTION NO. 26R-01-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPROVING THE "SIXTH AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND CITY OF LAUDERHILL FOR COMMUNITY SHUTTLE SERVICE"; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, Broward County and the City of Lauderhill entered into an Interlocal Agreement dated September 30, 2019, as amended November 16, 2020, September 24, 2021, December 5, 2023, November 5, 2024, and November 20, 2025 ("Agreement"), which provides for Community Shuttle Service as an alternative form of public transportation for residents within the jurisdictional limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into this Sixth Amendment to amend Exhibit F to establish new rates effective retroactive to October 1, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the "Sixth Amendment to Interlocal Agreement Between Broward County and City of Lauderhill for Community Shuttle Service" is hereby approved and the City Manager is authorized to execute the Sixth Amendment on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
