Subject: Handgun quotes

Members of the Training Unit have diligently been working on obtaining three total quotes for the purchase of the proposed duty handgun setup however; we are being met with some challenges. Officer C. Smith has emailed representatives with Nexus Shooting Range in Davie and Advanced Firearms in Margate however; he has not received any response. Officer C. Smith reached out to Dana Safety Supply who informed us they do not sell Glock handguns.

The two quotes we have received to this point are the below:

- Lou's Police Distributors at \$197,694.00
- GT Distributors at \$198,664.50

Both Lou's Police Distributors and GT Distributors are offering a buyback program to purchase our old duty handguns. After you factor in the trade in value being offered, the above quotes become the below:

- Lou's Police Distributors at \$164,069.00
- GT Distributors at \$159,079.50

On paper, GT Distributors is lower in cost however; they are located in Orange Park, Florida. Our trade in handguns would have to be shipped or hand delivered to their location to receive credit.


Lou's Police Distributors is located in Hialeah, Florida. I suggest we stick with a local purchase in the event we have any issues with any of our purchased equipment it will be a lot more convenient to deal with a local vendor.

As a result of the unit being unsuccessful in receiving a third quote from a vendor, Officer C. Smith individually priced all items included in the package build out using various company websites as if he was a civilian purchasing these items for private use. After pricing 150 Glock

Subject: Use of State Law Enforcement Trust Funds

In 2013, the police department purchased new Glock 22 firearms, utilizing State Law Enforcement Trust Funds, to replace earlier model Glock firearms that were beginning to have routine failures. Over the last eleven years, significant advances have been made in firearms sighting systems, making it better for officers to ensure they are on target, reducing liabilities. Additionally, there has been a movement, in local law enforcement, away from the .40 caliber round currently used by our department and going to a .9mm round. Finally, our weapons are more than ten years old and some are beginning to have mechanical failures.

The Police Department is requesting to utilize State Law Enforcement Trust Funds to purchase new firearms and the ancillary equipment needed to outfit our officers. Additionally, utilizing these funds, we are requesting to purchase the .9mm ammunition that is needed for the training and transition. The requested funds are not to exceed \$210,000. Funding for this purchase can be found in the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund, budget account 120.
