

**RESOLUTION NO. 25R-02-35**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF OBSOLETE, DAMAGED, INOPERABLE AND SURPLUS EQUIPMENT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ENGINEERING AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES (DEES) IN THE MOST COST-EFFECTIVE AND FAVORABLE MANNER PURSUANT TO CITY CODE SECTION 2-143; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY INTERIM ASSISTANT CITY MANAGER, SEAN HENDERSON) .**

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill Code of Ordinance, Section 2-143(b) provides methods for the disposal of surplus stock, equipment of furniture; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to dispose of obsolete, damaged, inoperable or surplus equipment from the department of Engineering and Environmental Services (DEES) in the most cost-effective and favorable manner subject to City Commission approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission hereby authorizes the disposal of obsolete, damaged, inoperable and/or surplus equipment from the Department of Engineering and Environmental Services (DEES) as described on the attached list, a copy of which is attached hereto as included herein, in the most cost effective and favorable manner pursuant to City Code Section 2-143.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
