WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to name the public service facility/community center located in the City Hall complex after Mayor Ken Thurston in his honor in recognition of his numerous attributes and contributions to and many years of service to the City of Lauderhill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Commission of the City of Lauderhill hereby names the "Ken Thurston Inverrary Community Center and Public Service Facility" which is located in the City Hall complex in honor of his numerous attributes and contributions and many years of service to the City of Lauderhill.

<u>Section 2</u>. That a plaque in his honor will be placed in a prominent location on the building.
