

RESOLUTION NO. 26R-02-44

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TERMINATE THE STATE HIGHWAY LIGHTING, MAINTENANCE, AND COMPENSATION AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CONTRACT NO. ASM27) SUBJECT TO REVIEW BY THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING THAT SUCH TERMINATION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2026, WITH MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES RETURNING TO FDOT EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROVIDE NOTICE AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE SAID TERMINATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill entered into an agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to maintain responsibilities for aging FDOT-owned lighting, however, maintaining the lighting has become cost-prohibitive and exceed the reimbursement provided under the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, if approved, the termination will take effect on June 30, 2026, and maintenance responsibilities will return to FDOT on July 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill finds that it is in the best interests of its residents to authorize the City Manager to terminate Contract No. ASM27 with FDOT, subject to the review of the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The above recitations are true and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to terminate the Agreement (Contract No. ASM27) with FDOT, subject to the review by the City Attorney, and to provide the appropriate notice to FDOT. The termination will take effect on June 30, 2026, with maintenance responsibilities returning to FDOT on July 1, 2026.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is further authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate the termination and the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
