

RESOLUTION NO. 26R-07-111

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS TO AUTHORIZE A PIGGYBACK OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, CONTRACT WITH NATIONAL METERING SERVICES, INC., FOR LEAD AND COPPER RULE REVISIONS (LCRR) SERVICE LINE MATERIAL INVENTORY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PIGGYBACK AGREEMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-144 of the City's Code, the City of Lauderhill ("City") may waive its requirements on competitive bidding and join in on cooperative purchasing plans when in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood, Florida, solicited competitive proposals from vendors to provide hand-digging at various locations throughout the City of Hollywood in IFB 082-23-JJ/22-5145 "Lead and Copper Rule Revisions Service Line Material Inventory" and National Metering Services, Inc., was awarded the contract; and

WHEREAS, Contractor entered into a contract with the City of Hollywood, Florida, on July 02, 2024, to provide the services to include special terms and conditions, general terms and conditions, etc. (collectively referred to as "Contract Documents" or the "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to "piggyback" onto the above referenced Contract between Contractor and City of Hollywood, Florida for utilization of the same or similar services and Contractor consents to the aforesaid "piggybacking".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The above recitations are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City is authorized to piggyback the City of Hollywood, Florida, contract IFB-082-23-JJ/22-5145 "Lead and Copper Rule Revisions Service Line Material Inventory" with National Metering Services, Inc.

SECTION 3. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to enter into the appropriate piggyback agreement with National Metering Services, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, and do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
