

RESOLUTION NO. 26R-06-99

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA SUPPORTING THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO) ROADS FOR ECONOMIC VITALITY (REV) SUBMITTAL FOR PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS ON N.W. 82ND AVENUE WHICH ALIGN WITH THE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT IN THE CITY'S TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN; ACKNOWLEDGING THAT THE CITY OWNS THE SUBJECT RIGHT-OF-WAYS WHERE THE PROJECTS ARE PROPOSED; CONFIRMING THE CITY'S COMMITMENT TO FUND THE PROJECTS OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) approved the Roads for Economic Vitality Program (REV) on July 9th, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill has proposed a transportation project funded by the MPO as part of the Roads for Economic Vitality (REV) involving multimodal enhancements and traffic calming along NW 82nd Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill hereby supports the multimodal enhancements and traffic calming improvement projects as defined herein, which will be evaluated and ranked by the MPO, then vetted to determine programmability in accordance with the REV policies; and

WHEREAS, a resolution from the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill stating support for the project is required to establish funding eligibility; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill commits to administer and deliver the project under the Local Agency Program (LAP); and

WHEREAS, the LAP program is reimbursement-based as specified in the LAP Agreement that will be entered into regarding the program when necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill commits to funding the upfront costs for the design, Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) services, and the construction costs will then be reimbursed in accordance with the terms of the LAP Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill commits to the program funding for construction contingency in accordance with the requirements of LAP; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill owns the subject rights-of-way where the improvement projects are proposed to be located; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill further agrees to continue to provide and fund the continued operation and maintenance (O&M) of the improvement projects once completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified as true, correct, confirmed, and adopted as a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby supports the transportation project proposed by the City of Lauderhill and funded by the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Roads for Economic Vitality Program (REV): the multimodal enhancements along NW 82nd Avenue, between W Commercial Blvd and NW 44th Street within the City of Lauderhill's rights-of-way.

SECTION 3. The City of Lauderhill acknowledges and confirms that it owns said rights-of-way where the improvement projects are proposed to be located.

SECTION 4. The City of Lauderhill agrees to commit to the program funding for construction contingency in accordance with the requirements of LAP for reimbursement in accordance with the LAP Agreement, and to continue to provide and fund the continued operation and maintenance (O&M) of the improvement projects once completed.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to send copies of this Resolution to the Broward MPO, the media, and to any other interested parties.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
