

RESOLUTION NO. 26R-06-103

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BY AND AMONG BROWARD COUNTY AND NUMEROUS MUNICIPALITIES AS IT RELATES TO THE NATIONAL POLLUTION DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) AND SHARING RESOURCE BURDENS OF THE SYSTEM-WIDE NPDES MS4 PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING BROWARD COUNTY TO CONDUCT TECHNICAL ACTIVITIES REQUIRED BY THE NPDES MS4 PERMIT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND OTHER APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, permits public agencies to enter interlocal agreements with each other to jointly exercise any power, privilege, or authority, which such agencies share in common and which each might exercise separately; and

WHEREAS, Broward County, the City of Lauderhill, and numerous other municipalities as set forth in the Interlocal Agreement, entered into the most recent Interlocal Agreement on November 7, 2017, to carry out tasks required by the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of continuing Broward County's services of coordinating the co-permittees pursuant to the NPDES MS4 Regulations, and managing and performing technical tasks necessary to comply with the NPDES MS4 Permit; and

WHEREAS, Broward County is willing to perform such services as set forth in the Interlocal Agreement, attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County and other municipalities relating to sharing the resource burdens of the system wide NPDES MS4 Permit and authorizing Broward County to conduct technical activities required by the NPDES MS4 Permit, said Interlocal Agreement, is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.

SECTION 2. The City Manager and other appropriate city officials are authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement, and the City Manager or designee is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
