A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE AMERICAN PUBLIC HEALTH ASSOCIATION (APHA) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000 TO IMPLEMENT THE CARDIFF VIOLENCE PREVENTION MODEL; AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH APHA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY INTERIM CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill and the American Public Health Association ("APHA") wish to enter into an agreement to provide four months of technical assistance and funding to implement the Cardiff Violence Prevention Model, a data-driven approach to reducing violent crime; and

WHEREAS, this initiative aligns with the City of Lauderhill's crime reduction priorities and will assist first responders in identifying crime hotspots to implement more strategic enforcement measures; and

WHEREAS, the grant will support ongoing collaboration between the Florida Department of Health, Lauderhill's Fire and Police Departments, and local health institutions, which has been in development for over two years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill finds that it is in the best interests of its residents to accept the grant and hereby authorizes the Interim City Manager to execute the Agreement with APHA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The \$30,000 grant from APHA is hereby accepted and the Interim City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement with APHA.
